ANDEO HOSTING PROGRAMS

HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAMS DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR

Nationality: French & Spanish
Type: Attend high school
Length: 2-3 weeks
Dates: Spring (French) & Fall (Spanish)

Students will attend high school with their American host brother or sister. Evenings and weekends are spent with their host families.

HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER PROGRAMS

Nationalities: French, Spanish, German
Type: Immersion & Study
Length: 2 - 7 weeks
Dates: Mid-June - August

Immersion students are entirely free to adjust to your schedule. Study students attend English classes and activities on weekdays and spend evenings and weekends with their host families.

COLLEGE SPRING & SUMMER PROGRAMS (Portland area)

Nationalities: Japanese, Korean, Taiwanese and others
Type: Study
Length: 1 - 5 weeks
Dates: January through Sept.

Students attend classes and activities at PSU or PCC each weekday, and spend evenings and weekends with their host families. They use Tri-Met to commute.

The Students:

All students are eager to discover American life! They have chosen a homestay program so they can learn first-hand what it is like to live in the U.S. The high school students are between the ages of 13-19 and have studied English in school. The college students are 18 and older and are studying English in college. All students bring their own spending money and are covered by insurance.

The Host Families:

Host families provide room and board, and family life for the students. The students need to have their own bed, but may share a room with another teenager. The students participate as members of the family, not as guests. Students and families are matched according to their special interests and requests as much as possible. It is not necessary to speak a foreign language because the students want to practice their English and experience American culture.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAMS

...During the school year

What will the students do during the day? The students shadow their host brother or sister at school. They sit in on classes and assist French or Spanish teachers as requested. They are great conversation partners and add cultural insight to discussions!

Do we need to obtain permission from the school?

Yes. The school needs to approve your student's visit. We have a packet of information to send to the administrator to help obtain permission.

What kind of support does your program provide? The students travel with a group leader who will call you during the stay. A staff member is always available to assist you if you have any questions or problems. We have a 24-hour number in case of emergency.

...During the summer

What do we do with the students? The students participate in the daily activities of your family. Helping with family chores, visiting friends, riding bikes and exploring your town all help them to understand American family life.

What if we go on vacation? No problem. You may take your student with you when you travel—just let us know when and where you go!
