HOMESTAY IN FRANCE!

Fly with your group to Paris, then travel by train to your waiting host family. Immerse yourself in French culture as a member of a welcoming French family! Share your summer with local teens, learn the secrets of French cuisine, and join in the flow of daily life and conversation in a French community. Your group may choose to end the stay with a fabulous three-day tour of Paris, where students will put their French to practical use as you navigate the City of Lights. Experience the heart of the Impressionist art movement, stroll down the Champs-Élysées, and capture the afternoon light in a photo of the Arc de Triomphe or Tour Eiffel.

TENTATIVE DATES: One month in Summer, 2009

***ESTIMATED PRICE: \$1,600 - \$1,750**

(An all inclusive 3-day tour of Paris could be added for an additional \$700 per student)

These prices include:

- Transportation in France
- Homestay placement with all meals
- Pre-departure orientation materials
- Comprehensive medical and emergency return insurance
- Group trip delay insurance
- One chaperone's costs
- 24-hour emergency contact number while the students are in France.

*Estimated prices based on a minimum group size of ten students and one teacher chaperone. **These prices do not include airfare.** We will coordinate flights from the city of your choice to Paris. Contact us for a price that includes airfare. Airfare is estimated from \$1,600, depending on the departure city. Final price will vary depending on actual group size, Paris tour activities, and airfare (airline taxes and fuel surcharges are subject to change until final purchase).

PREREQUISITES:

This program is open to students who have studied French for the equivalent of at least two years in high school and who meet the program requirements. Please see the sample Behavior Agreement.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

Complete the reservation form and return it to Andeo along with a \$300 deposit by the reservation form due date. This will reserve your place in the program contingent upon satisfactory completion of the application process. You will then receive a detailed application packet by email that will be due approximately 4 weeks later.

SAMPLE PAYMENT SCHEDULE:

November 15, 2008	\$300 (with reservation form)
January 15, 2009	\$1,100 (with completed application packet)
March 1, 2009	\$1,100
May 1, 2009	Final balance due

CANCELLATION POLICY:

If a student is not accepted for the program, all payments will be refunded in full. If a student cancels his/her application, the following policies apply:

Before completed application due date:	\$100 of \$300 deposit will be refunded
After completed application due date:	Full refund less \$300 deposit and any non-refundable costs incurred for the airline ticket and program.*

*Airline tickets must be purchased at least 90 days before departure and are non-refundable. If a student has followed the payment schedule and cancels after tickets have been purchased, he/she will receive the ticket. Refund and rebooking terms vary.

All cancellations must be received in writing at the ANDEO office by the cancellation date.

OTHER:

- You are responsible for paying for and obtaining your own passport.
- You will be asked to provide three written references, one from your French teacher, one from another teacher/coach/school administrator, and one from another adult (not a family member).
- We recommend that you bring about \$100-\$150 per week spending money for meals in transit, snacks, personal items, and souvenirs.

Paris Tour Itinerary

3 days in summer 2009

DAY ONE

Morning Arrive in Paris around noon and check into hotel

Morning Explore the *Musée du Louvre*

DAY THREE

Morning Visit the *Place de la Concorde*, the *Champs Elysées*, and the *Arc de Triomphe*
