Seville

The capital of Andalusia, Seville is an explosion of color and contrast between the modern and the traditional. Long considered to be one of the most beautiful cities in Spain, it has evolved into a cosmopolitan and multicultural town where the greatest Flamenco artists mix with the latest trends in contemporary arts. Its historical and cultural heritage, lively atmosphere and comfortable climate make it the ideal place to study Spanish.

The Language Institute

Located in the heart of the city, the institute is less than 10 minutes from the beach, the city center and the bus station. It is housed in an historical mansion, just a short walking distance from Seville's major points of interest. During breaks, you can sip a *café con leche* in the central patio and get to know other students from around the world. The roof top terrace is a great place to relax before or after classes and there are 20 classrooms, a library and multimedia room.

The Classes

All classes are taught by native speakers who have been trained in teaching Spanish as a foreign language. The emphasis is on developing communicative skills, and students will have plenty of opportunities to communicate in 20 classes each week! Students take either a morning session or an afternoon session with 6-10 students in each class.

Cultural Activities

Activities take place in the afternoon or evening and include sports, lectures, excursions and parties. In addition, weekend excursions give you the opportunity to visit nearby towns or to explore the local mountains and beaches. Visit Cordoba, Cádiz, even Morocco!

Special Options: Flamenco or Hispanic Studies!

Lovers of traditional Spanish music can study the dance or guitar styles of Flamenco. Study for one hour each day, Monday through Thursday, after your language classes. Advanced students can enhance their linguistic skills through the study of literature and the history of Spanish language. Call for details and start dates.

Accommodations

Your Spanish fluency will improve daily as you share conversations with your local host family. You will live with a family that has been carefully selected, in a home that is within walking distance or a short bus ride to school. Accommodations include breakfast and lunch; dinner option also available.



Frequently Asked Questions

What does the cost include? Application processing, pre-departure orientation materials, homestay placement with breakfast and lunch, study materials, cultural activities and on-site support are included in the cost. The students can also take advantage of the facilities such as the sun terrace, the pool and the multimedia room at no extra charge.

Can I study if I am a beginner? Yes, beginners are welcome to participate in this program, but start dates are generally every other Monday. Please contact us for details.

When will I receive my host family placement information? You will receive host family details and contact information in the week prior to your class starting date.

Will there be an orientation session in Seville? Yes. On your first day of class, you will have the opportunity to join an introductory walk around the city that covers both places of historic interest and useful services such as banks, post offices, markets etc.

Will I have access to email? Yes, the institute has a computer room, and all students can access email and the internet. The campus also offers a wireless LAN connection.

Will the institute be closed for any holidays? Yes. The dates are: January 1 and 6, May 1, October 12, November 1, December 8, 8, and 25.

Do I need travel insurance? We strongly recommend that you get travel insurance that includes a medical plan. Prices depend upon trip length and participant age. You can compare different policies online or by contacting your local travel agent.

Can I get credits for studying abroad? Yes! Whether you are a high school graduate, a university student working toward a degree, or a teacher working on professional development, you can get credit for continuing your education abroad. Earn 5 to 10 credits by signing up for a variety of courses offered by We Study Abroad, an accredited college program linked with Seattle Central Community College. Can I speak to people that have attended the program before? Definitely! Please contact our office and we can provide you with emails for students who have participated in this program before.

How do I apply? To apply, complete an initial application and return it with a \$300 deposit. You can download an application at www.andeo.org. This deposit will be applied to the total program price. Upon receipt of your program registration and deposit, we will send you a detailed orientation packet. The balance of your program fees will be due 30 days before your program start date.

What is your cancellation policy? If you cancel your program more than 45 days prior to your start date, we will refund the amount you have paid toward your program fee except for the \$100 non-refundable deposit and any cancellation fees charged by the language school. The cancellation fees vary from school to school, so please feel free to ask us about the fees that apply to your program. For cancellations made less than 45 days prior to your program start date, your \$300 deposit will be forfeited, and you will also be responsible for the cancellation fees charged by the language school. If Andeo cancels your program, you will receive a full refund.
